1) Open to any youth 12 to 18 years in the Haliburton Highlands area who can submit a 5 minute video clip with a blues cover song for pre judging to qualify for an invite to the May 25 panel of final judging

- 2) Seeking youth talent vocal, instruments and with a blues direction
- 3) Parental release is required for finalist entry to qualify for prizes and permission for any media coverage.
